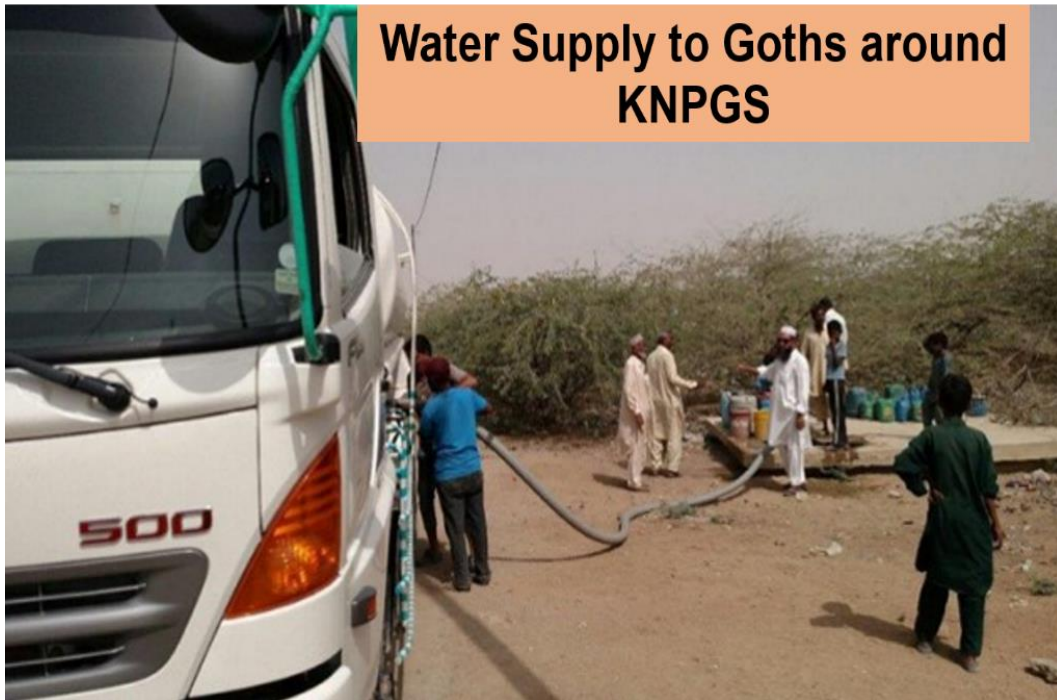
PAEC has planted more than

Chairman Pakistan Atomic Energy Commission (PAEC) Muhammad Naeem (HI,SI) handed over furniture worth Rs. 2Million to Government Girls Higher Secondary School, Kundian district Mianwali on 12th Nov 2021 under CSR Program.
